The purpose of the conference is to discuss of a wide range of theoretical and practical issues and topics related to various aspects of pedagogy, psychology and methods of teaching of foreign languages; to combine the efforts of scientists and practitioners to determine relevant areas of research; to strengthen ties between Russian and foreign universities; to encourage of scientific initiative of teachers and students; to establish of international cooperation in educational and research activities; to establish partnerships in the scientific and educational environment

Working languages of the conference: Russian, English

Participation format: in-person (giving a presentation with a report and/or as a listener without delivering a report), virtual participation (delivering a report via Internet broadcast), by correspondence (by publishing a conference paper in conference proceedings). The applicant should indicate the format of participation

The following participants of the conference are invited: students, undergraduates and graduate students of linguistic and non-linguistic specialties, scientists and university teachers, professional translators, representatives of translation organizations.

The procedure for providing conference papers by participants

Abstracts and application forms (hereinafter referred to as paper materials) are accepted until May 05, 2023 to the email address: e.aleksandrova@spbacu.ru

Based on the results of the conference, an electronic conference proceedings with papers of the participants is published, which will be placed in the scientometric database of the RSCI. The conference proceedings with conference papers will be assigned library indexes UDC (Universal Decimal Classification), LBC (Library-Bibliographical Classification), international standard number (ISBN).

Conference participants receive certificates. The cost of the certificate is 250 rubles.

Registration fee for publication in the conference proceedings - 1000 rubles.

Abstract submission requirements

- The authors submit papers for consideration in the form of an electronic folder, including:
- application form (example: application_Ivanov_II). Application Form Annex 1;

- theses (example: theses_Ivanov_II). Template for abstracts - Appendix 2.

The electronic version of an application form and a paper are submitted in MS Word text editor with *.doc or *.docx extension.

- Volume of a paper: 3 5 pages, including the list of sources. One publication can contain no more than one figure, one table, three formulas.
- Figures and tables are denoted as Figure 1. or Table 1. Graphs, figures are inserted as an embedded object and are included in the paper text. The originals of the posted images are attached as separate files in .jpg, .pdf format with a resolution of at least 300 dpi; recommended text in tables, captions, bibliographic list 11 pt.
- Text MSWord editor, font Times New Roman, point size 14, page width alignment, no hyphenation, line spacing 1.5; paragraph indent 1 cm; all fields 2 cm; pages are not numbered.
- Paper structure:

- bibliographic index UDC (Universal Decimal Classification) is placed at the beginning of the paper on a separate line on the left;

- the title of the paper is provided in Russian language in lower case letters, center alignment;

- information about the author (authors): full name, university, city, country, e-mail address, ORCID (if available); lower case letters, justified alignment;

- abstract (volume 150-250 words) is provided in Russian language, aligned to the width of the page;

- keywords (5-7) are provided in Russian language, page width alignment;

- the title of the paper is provided in English language in lower case letters, center alignment;

- information about the author (authors) is repeated in English language (full name and surname, patronymic is reduced to 1 letter);

- abstract (volume 150-250 words) is provided in English language, aligned to the width of the page;

- keywords (5-7) are provided in English language, page width alignment;

- the list of sources includes only those sources that are referenced to in the text of the article. Literature sources are listed in alphabetical order of authors. References to the literature and notes in the text have the following form: [source number, source page].

- Articles received later than the 5th of May, 2023, as well as those that do not correspond to the subject of the conference and the rules of registration, will not be published.
- The authors are fully responsible for the content and literacy of the materials provided.
- Abstracts are checked using the plagiarism detection system Antiplagiat. If there are illegal borrowings and lack of originality, the materials will not be accepted. The minimum acceptable level of originality of the text is 70% according to the system of antiplagiarism.
